

## YJ Door Opening Measurements

In order to prevent costly returns and ensure complete customer satisfaction, we ask that customers please check two measurements before ordering a set of our YJ Upper doors.

### History

For a short period of time during the production of the YJ, Chrysler Corp. was forced to import a hardtop that did not meet their OEM specifications. These hardtops do not have any identifying marks or serial numbers and were sold with soft upper doors that fit their door opening. Because these tops do not have an OEM opening for the upper doors, factory hard doors and **our upper doors will not fit.**

### Measurements

Our upper doors for the YJ are designed to fit an OEM specified door opening. To determine if your hardtop has an OEM door opening, two measurements will be required.

1. With the door closed, measure the distance from the forward top corner of the lower door to the seam in the hardtop where the side panel and roof panel meet. This measurement should be approximately 39 ½ inches. If you have one of the above mentioned tops, your opening will be about 1 ½ inches less.
2. With the door closed, measure the distance from the forward top corner of the lower door to the closest edge of the top on the same plane. This measurement should be approximately 34 ½ inches. If you have one of the above mentioned tops, your opening will be about 1 ½ inches less.
